INSTALLATION METHODS

Fully Bonded	Yes (recommended)
Nailed	Yes
Floated on underlay	Yes
Over Underfloor Heating	Yes (see below*)

*The underfloor heating system must have an even temperature over the entire floor surface. The sub floor temperature that the floor boards are sitting on cannot exceed 27°c. The heating system must be working two weeks prior to install. Once the floor is installed, acclimatise the wood flooring by turning the heating temperature up 1°c per day (18-27°c) then back down 1°c per day. This is to not shock the wood, which can cause cracking and shrinking.

GRADING CRITERIA

Select grade is more uniform in colour than natural rustic and super rustic grade, with very few and small knots. No cracks and spilts. Only very few and small natural defects are allowed.
