INSTALLATION METHODS

Fully Bonded	Yes (recommended)

Over Underfloor Heating	Yes (see below*)

*The underfloor heating system must have an even temperature over the entire floor surface. The sub floor temperature that the floor boards are sitting on cannot exceed 27°c. The heating system must be working two weeks prior to install. Once the floor is installed, acclimatise the wood flooring by turning the heating temperature up 1°c per day (18-27°c) then back down 1°c per day. This is to not shock the wood, which can cause cracking and shrinking.

GRADING CRITERIA

Natural grade includes variations in colour tone from plank to plank, with more noticeable markings such as knots, streaks, sapwood and fine cracks. The grading is perfect for owners who want a non-uniform, natural wood floor.
